BLUEBELL WOODS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 17 – Thursday 18 April Cost: £155



Using your own reference – photo's or sketches, we will plan a painting that takes us on a walk through dappled sunlight and bluebell woods, capturing the vibrancy of the blues and violets set against the spring greens. Fresh and exciting.

MAY 2024

SPRING MEADOWS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday I – Thursday 2 May

Cost: £155



Cow parsley grows in abundance along our hedgerows and in Spring meadows and this will be the subject matter for our workshop – the type of subject matter we come across on a daily basis. We will focus not necessarily on pretty views or breathtaking scenes – but landscape looking over meadows and along hedgerows concentrating on lots of texture and colour.

BEACHES, PEBBLES & ROCKS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Thursday 30 – Friday 31 May

Cost: £150



We will be concentrating how to paint beaches, create pebbles and rocks using various expressive mark making techniques leaving out minute detail but including just enough!

JUNE 2024

INTERESTING FOREGROUNDS IN WATERCOLOUR PLUS

I -day Thursday 6 June Cost: £78

JULY 2024

KEEPING A SKETCHBOOK & PAINTING THE 'FEELING'

2-day Wednesday 24 - Thursday 25 July 2024



This workshop will focus on the unique challenges of plein air painting (outdoors). The ability to see and simplify, to organise the subject matter, and to present it in a simple and straightforward manner in watercolour, mixed media and acrylics. The workshop will include demonstrations as well as individual attention. You will need to be fairly active and mobile. Day One: Painting outdoors in watercolour + ink/pastel - gathering source material in the form of sketches and photographs for use in the studio.

Day Two: Painting the feeling (in the studio) - you will use your sketches as preliminary work to use as a starting point for a considered finished painting in acrylics or mixed media translating them into exciting and zingy artwork.

AUGUST 2024

MOOD & ATMOSPHERE IN ACRYLICS

I-day Wednesday 21 August

Cost: £78



Ideal if you're a beginner or if you're fairly experienced. This workshop is about putting your interpretation on the subject by painting on a coloured ground and working in many thin layers, 'scumbling' the paint. It's an extremely exciting and satisfying way of working and suits all levels of ability from newcomers to acrylics to exhibiting artists! Ideal if you want to loosen up and be more expressive.

SEPTEMBER 2024

INTERESTING FOREGROUNDS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 18 – Thursday 19 September 2024 Cost: £155



Very often tangled brambles, a busy hedgerow or a complicated foreground generally, can deter you from picking up your paintbrush! This workshop concentrates on turning such subject matter into an interesting foreground, almost making it the focal point with lots of interest. Create movement and energy in a painting by incorporating texture with a semi-abstract approach.

DRIPS, DROPS AND SPLATS IN ACRYLICS and INK!

2-day Wednesday 25 - Thursday 26 September 2024



This workshop uses acrylics very wet, flooding the canvas with colour, moving it around and letting the paint run and drip, glazing with thin transparent washes and introducing acrylic inks. Really exciting! The 2-day workshop will give you time to develop compositional planning and ideas, analyse mark making and finishing off a painting. Painting for your own inspiration.

OCTOBER 2024

SKIES & REFLECTIONS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 9 – Thursday 10 October 2024 Cost: £155



Concentrating on the subject of painting skies, moving clouds, water and reflections, we will consider colour mixing and layering to create glowing and luminous results!

EXPERIMENTAL WATERCOLOURS AND MIXED MEDIA

2-day Wednesday 16 – Thursday 17 October 2024 Cost: £155



This workshop will encourage you to stop fiddling and loosen up your watercolour techniques! A series of stimulating demonstrations and exercises in composition, the expressive use of colour, pigment application and dynamic ways of applying paint, all designed to encourage well-planned yet spontaneous watercolour paintings.

LOVE YOUR COLOURS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 30 – Thursday 31 October Cost: £155



Ideal if you're a beginner or if you're fairly experienced. Concentrating on the use of colour first and foremost – Using a limited and expressive colour palette, exploring a range of colour combinations using a loose and free approach to create a considered painting in acrylics.

NOVEMBER 2024

PAINTING WITH TEXTURE AND ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 13 – Thursday 14 November 2024 Cost: £155



We will set out with the clear intention of incorporating texture into our work - texture/modeling paste, tissue paper, sand - anything to give another dimension to our work and exciting, expressive results!

EXCITING ADVENTURES IN ACRYLICS

2-day Thursday 21 – Friday 22 November 2024 Cost: £155



Ideal if you're a beginner or indeed if you're fairly experienced, we will experiment with lots of techniques for a fairly relaxed but well structured 2-days! From playing with paint and mark making, we will then plan to complete a considered painting based on a subject you choose using one or more of the techniques learned.

TECHNIQUES IN ACRYLICS AND LANDSCAPE ABSTRACTIONS

2-day Wednesday 27 – Thursday 28 November 2024 Cost: £155



The landscape will be the framework which you will build on to move into abstraction. Some people paint abstracts entirely from their imaginations, but having something 'real' as the starting point gives a direction to start working in, to kickstart your imagination. We will work on some techniques in acrylics on Day I and begin working on a 'design' for our finished work. Whether you are already working in landscape and want a little more edge to your work or are trying to find an approach to abstraction, this workshop should help you.

VIBRANT COLOURFUL LANDSCAPES IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday II – Friday I3 December 2024 Cost: £232



Translate thought and emotion into your art.
This workshop concentrates on creating **exciting landscapes**.... not 'chocolate box' scenes but paintings full of feeling, atmosphere and excitement, putting your own personal stamp on the subject. A different technique each day!
Techniques in mark making – working in layers and scumbling the paint; painting with a palette knife; and incorporating collage. A non-traditional approach designed to energize participants toward adventurous painting and individualised expression.

DECEMBER 2024

A WINTER SNOW SCENE IN ACRYLICS 2-day Wednesday 4 – Thursday 5 December 2024



We will tackle how to paint a cold, frosty snow scene whilst achieving a warm glow, analyzing the effect of the light on the landscape, looking at shadows and how to paint them using glazes and layers.

'WATERCOLOUR SKETCHING AND ISLAND HOPPING IN THE ISLES OF SCILLY'
St Mary's, Isles of Scilly

Saturday 31 August – Friday 6 September 2024 Limited to 8-10 places



Join me on St Mary's in the Isles of Scilly, where we will be based in Hugh Town. We will explore each of the islands filling sketchbooks alongside sweeping sea views and undeveloped rugged coasts.

You may be aware that I have run an 'Island Hopping & Watercolour Sketching' Holiday in the Isles of Scilly for the past 4 years. We have a fabulous week visiting all five inhabited islands and painting as we island hop! The weather is generally glorious (although of course cannot be guaranteed) and there is even some optional paddling and swimming involved.

The dates are:

Saturday 31 August 2024 – arrive on St Mary's Sunday 1 September 2024 – Friday 6 September 2024 FREE day on Wednesday Saturday 7 September – leave St Mary's

What is included and cost:

The cost is £495 not including travel or accommodation. There are many variables – like flying by helicopter or plane or sailing; swanky hotels or camping and everything in between. I can help you with this if you need you're not sure. What is required: £160 deposit on booking and final payment by 8 July 2024.

If you would like to join me, it is important to book your accommodation soon. The Islands are popular with returning visitors, they tend to rebook their accommodation year on year and therefore the sooner you reserve your accommodation the better. You will need to stay in Hugh Town on St Mary's.

You have to be fit and active as there is a fair amount of walking (sometimes up to 5 miles) over uneven surfaces as well as carrying your kit. You will also be required to get on and off small boats and climb fairly steep granite quayside steps. It is also important to be agile enough to be happily seated on the ground at times.

Glenthorne Guest House is a Victorian Country House set in its own gardens in one of the most beautiful and peaceful locations in Grasmere in the heart of the English Lake District.

The holiday will consist of some plein air watercolour painting, gathering source material in the form of sketches, photographs and turning the sketches into finished paintings in the studio. We will sketch in watercolours and pen and produced finished paintings in acrylics and mixed media.

What is included and cost:

Tuition and accommodation to be paid separately. The cost of accommodation includes:

- Tuition £320 per person
- £450 per person single en suite.
- £490 per person double/twin en suite with single occupancy
- Full Board for 3 nights (packed lunches Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday), and Dinner B&B for your last evening (no packed lunches on departure day).
- All rooms have garden / mountain view.
- A non-refundable **deposit of £160** is required to secure your place.
